A team of 18 writers – unique individuals from a variety of disciplines including academics, entrepreneurship, and small business ownership – was assembled and given the task of creating a comprehensive curriculum on best practices for small business and business plan development. The result consists of manuals and workbooks entitled Entrepreneur, Start-Up, Going Global, Buzz on Biz, and Micro. The material was revised and updated in September 2010 and includes the launch of Spanish translations. NxLeveL<sup>®</sup> is now also available on line for those who cannot participate in a live class.

Michael C. Finnerty, the President/CEO of NxLeveL<sup>®</sup> since 2002, is a third generation entrepreneur whose family has successfully run their businesses for nearly a century. In addition to his entrepreneurial experience, He holds a Bachelors Degree in Finance and a Masters in Business Administration.
